Sanitisation supplies to be provided in home, away and referee changing areas.


Social distancing means the number of players in a changing room may be restricted to a maximum of 12 at any one time. Players may change in rotation.

Team talks to take place outside where possible.

No more than 3 players in the showers at any one time.

Players shall provide their own water bottle for personal use and ensure it is filled.





Clubs should keep a record of all attendees at a match, including contact details, to support NHS Test and Trace. This is a secretary responsibility.

Opposition to provide details of attendees on or before arrival.

Spectators shall be limited to the capacity number dictated by the Football Association, 200 until September 1st, 400 thereafter.

All spectators to enter through one turnstile where they will register for the track and trace information either via smartphone and QR code or have their details taken by an official otherwise.

Sanitisation stations to be provided at turnstile and clubhouse entrance.

Match day stewards will be	
employed to help in advising	
the guidelines where	
required.	
Spectators will be encouraged	
to social distance within the	
ground even though operating	
well below capacity levels and	
use alternate seats in seated	
areas.	
The club house will be	
thoroughly cleaned and tables	
sanitised for each game and	
will currently only open on	
football match days.	
The club house will operate a	
one-way system whereby	
customers enter through the	
front doors and exit from the	
side.	
Gaming machines and pool	
table to be switched off and	
covered respectively to	
prevent use.	
Furniture arranged to allow	
social distancing within the	
premises.	

	Only cans and bottles will be served, and decanted into disposable plastic glasses.
	There will be no hot food provision within the ground.
